JUDGES HAVE BEEN CHOSEN FOR THE LIGHT HORSE SHOW AT THE OHIO STATE FAIR

- **Mrs. Mary Jo Schmidt** of Riverview, Florida will judge the American Saddlebred, Saddle Seat Equitation, Open Pleasure, Friesian, Parade and Ohio Hackney Futurity classes.
- **Mr. Randy Harper** of Simpsonville, Kentucky will judge the Hackney horse & pony divisions
- **Mr. Patrick Sanders**, Mazon, Illinois will judge the Shetland & American Show Pony classes.
- **Mr. James Vernon**, Louisville, Kentucky will judge the American Miniature Horse Division.

What's New :

- **The new Open Pleasure Division will be represented with open hunt seat, saddleseat and pleasure driving classes.** These classes represent a new point category for TriState Horse Shows Association. A select number of Friesian classes will be offered. These new classes will enhance an already ambitious schedule.
- **The Shetland & AMHR Classes are now part of the Ohio State Fair Championships.** Triple points are offered for the All Star program in the ASPCR/AMHR Registry. One stall fee, one hauling fee and one entry fee for triple points certainly is a bargain in today's economy.
- **Look for liberty classes & Hunter & Jumper classes for AMHR horses, both over & under.**
- **The Modern Shetland Weanling Sweepstakes will be highlighted on Wednesday evening July 21.** Special display area will be provided for promotion of the nominated stallions along the green wall.

What stays the same:

- **The American Shetland Pony Club Area 2 directors and the American Hackney Horse Society along with the Ohio Hackney Association will again host the hospitality room for all exhibitors. All exhibitors are welcome.**
- **The total prize money offered is over \$100,000 along with several jackpot classes.** It is also a qualifying show for ASHA division at the Louisville World Championships. Show your horses in a premier facility before you go to Louisville and before the ASPC Congress!!
- **The Ohio Expo Center offers one of the premier horse show facilities in the Midwest.** The Gilligan complex offers over 1000 permanent stalls under one roof, well lighted makeup ring, acres of parking and camping adjacent to the show facility. The spacious, well-lighted Pepsi Coliseum will seat over 6000 people and offers many large box seat spaces.
- **There is easy access by air or ground.** The Columbus International Airport is within minutes of the Ohio Expo Center and interstate highways I-71 or I-70 provide easy access from any direction.
